Ottawa, May 17, 2021 – The Galt Museum & Archives were awarded the prestigious Canadian Museums Association (CMA) Award of Outstanding Achievement in Stewardship of Collections at this year's CMA Conference.

In addition to celebrating achievement, the CMA Awards uplift and inspire by helping set community benchmarks of excellence. All are awarded following a competitive process and peer review by a volunteer jury.

The Award of Outstanding Achievement for excellence in Stewardship of Collections, recognizes exceptional museum projects that see to the preservation of intangible culture heritage, including relevant digital practices and documentation.
